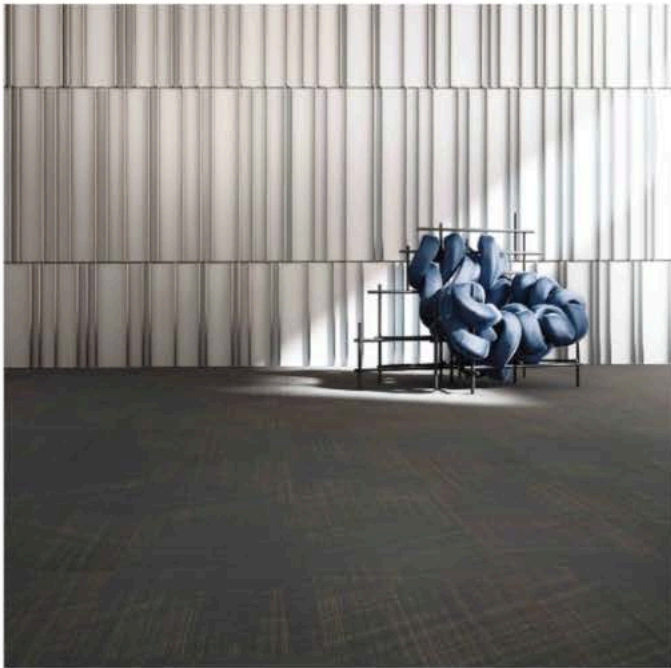

1 **Patcraft** explores the filigree openwork found in basketry and hand-loomed woven materials to create Digital Weave, a carpet with a traditional artisan approach. The series comes in a range of neutral and saturated jewel tones. PATCRAFT.COM

2 Named after the Gaelic word for rock, **Brintons'** Craigend is influenced by natural textures and surfaces like sand dunes, stone, moss, and lichen. Designed by Timorous Beasties, the collection is made from a blend of nylon and wool. BRINTONS.NET

3 Made in Turkey using viscose and polyester, **Surya's** Milano collection of rugs is machine-woven and offered in five colors, including light gray, medium gray, tan, white, and charcoal. SURYA.COM
